SATs WEEK Monday 8th May to Thursday 11th May 2017

It is important to be aware that the National SATs for Year 6 are taking place. I have included a timetable:

Monday 8th May	English reading test
Tuesday 9th May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 1: questions English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 2: spelling
Wednesday 10th May	Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic test Mathematics Paper 2: reasoning
Thursday 11th May	Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning

How you can help:

- Ensure your child gets to school on time (the tests have to be administered at prescribed times).
- Make sure that your child gets plenty of sleep.
- It's important that the children eat a good breakfast in order to help them sustain their concentration.
- Make sure they have a bottle of water to keep them hydrated.
- Please contact the office as soon as possible if your child is ill. It maybe that your child will be able to sit the test at school and then go straight home afterwards.

The children are also allowed to bring a mascot to put on their tables and I have reminded them to make sure the mascot is of a sensible size (nothing too big!).

Finally I would just like to say how incredibly proud I am of all the children in Year 6. They have worked hard all year and shown a very good attitude in preparing for these tests.
