on standardized tests

1:00

minute per day

will be exposed to
8,000
words per year
and scores in
10th PERCENTILE
on standardized tests

Top Tips for at home...

10 minute reading

Time for reading and time for discussion

- Don't read the whole book!
- Prediction
- Expression
- Punctuation
- Vocabulary
- Re-read for pace and fluency.

What to do if your child is stuck

- Use phonics first
- Read to the end of the sentence
 - What is the text about?
 - Does it sound right?
 - Look at the picture.



Reading in School

Guided Reading

Expectation in School

- High expectations
- Preparing for KS2 SATs

Pupil A

Reads 20 minutes each day
3600 minutes in a school year
1,800,000 words



Pupil B

Reads 5 minutes each day
900 minutes in a school year
282,000 words



Pupil C

Reads 1 minute each day
180 minutes in a school year



By the end of Year **Pupil A** will have read the equivalent of 60 whole school days. **Pupil B** will have read only 12 school days.
Which pupil would you expect to have a better vocabulary?
Which pupil would you expect to be more successful in school?
...and in life?

Children who read for just 15 minutes a day, in one year will have read over 1,000,000 words!
